Feed Back Analysis Report

Academic Year 2014-2015

Academic year commencement: - In the academic year 2014-2015, the first semester commenced on 1/7/2014 and concluded on 18/10/2014. The Second Semester commenced on 13/11/2014 and concluded on 30/4/2015.

For inspiring students the college arranged the program of 'Inauguration of Academic Year' on 10th August, 2014 and invited Hon'ble Justice Gyan Sudha Mishra, former Judge, Supreme Court of India and Hon'ble Justice Vikas Kingaonkar, former Judge Bombay High court.

With the objective of understanding the effectiveness of teaching learning, curriculum delivery and the performance of the college, every year the college takes the feedback of various stakeholders. The college is having following feedback processes:

1. **Feedback of faculty:-** Feedback of the faculty from students is the measure adopted by the college for ascertaining the quality of teaching of lecturers, for analyzing the percolation of knowledge among students and most importantly for understanding the remedial measures required to be adopted for improving the learning process of students. Twice in the academic year, i.e. in the first and second semester, feedback of the faculty is taken from students. Students give this feedback as to various aspects such as contents of lecture, command on language, approach of the faculty towards the class, query clarification, subject knowledge of the teacher etc. Twenty feedbacks received from students are selected as samples and processed for calculating the percentage of faculty with respect to the subject taught.

2. **Feedback of events:** - Every year the college conducts competitions such as, Late Shri Shankarrao Chavan Memorial State Level Elocution Competition, Justice P. B. Sawant National Moot Court Competition along with various intra collegiate competitions. Feedback of the participants of these activities is also taken for improving the quality of these programs.
3. **Feedback of advocates and firms providing internships to our students:** - The placement Cell of our college provides Summer and winter internships to students. The Placement Cell collects the feedback of students who have successfully completed internships.

Following are our findings:-

This academic year thirteen full time faculties along with a team of visiting faculties discharged the work of teaching the curriculum designed by the Pune University. The feedback of faculties for the subjects taught by them is received and analyzed. Following is the analysis of feedback of faculties with their respective subjects:-

Observations:-

1. Feedback of Faculties:-

- a. It is found that the average feedback of all faculties is above 60% and it is satisfactory.
- b. The Average performance was found ranging good to excellent in terms of score. But in few courses it was noticed to be average. Scope of improvement in terms of score was noticed in few subjects as the score can be improved for excellent grade.

2. Feedback of Events:- The college has received excellent feedback with respect to the organization of justice P.B. Sawant National Moot Court Competition. Some student participants have given suggestions regarding accommodation arrangement.

3. Feedback of interneers:- Overall feedback of student interneers is good. Some of firms or organizations have expressed the need of having more practical approach towards the syllabus. Some of them expressed the change in the university syllabus for making it practically relevant.

Action taken Report

Action taken:-

- The feedback for the academic year 2014-2015 and its analysis were discussed in detail by the Principal Mrs. Kranti Deshmukh in staff meeting. It was observed that even though this feedback seems to be satisfactory, there is scope for improvisation. Various measures such as PPT presentations, Group Discussions, Regular Assignments and presentations by students were suggested to be utilized for improving teaching learning process.
- The feedback was informed to individual faculty in person.
- Suggestions, Counselling and Support have been provided to concerned faculty for teaching-learning performance improvement.
- Taking in consideration the feedback regarding accommodation arrangement for Justice P.B. Sawant Moot Court Competition, in the next competition, provision was decided to be made for accommodation in hotel instead of hostel without compromising the security concerns.
- For further action and suggestion, the feedback analysis report, is forwarded to Local Management Committee.

Further Action Taken:-

- The Feedback analysis report was put before the Local Management Committee. In the meeting of LMC, the feedback received is observed to be satisfactory. It was suggested that in addition to the existing feedback processes the college should take feedback from students about the curriculum and from parents about their experience with the institution. This suggestion was decided to be implemented from the next academic year 2015-2016.
