- Various innovative methods of teaching and learning are adopted by the faculty to increase students participation in classrooms like student teacher seminars, class presentations by the students, case study method etc. Effective use of information and communication technology is made. Use of power point, screening of movies are done followed by an open house debate. In addition remedial teaching course conducted. Other activities and cells are working in specialized areas of law and to cover issues which are not covered in regular curricular. Experts are called to interact with the students. Expert faculty is invited from time to time to share their domain knowledge..

### **Legal Aid Camp-**

Legal aid camp was organized at Khanpur, Taluka Haveli, District Pune. In this camp student interacted with villagers and authorities and members of Gram Panchayat and tried to understand their problems and hurdles in the enforcement of their rights. They observed that due to hike in prizes of immovable property in Pune, nearby village property disputes are constantly increasing. The students shared with the villagers the legal knowledge regarding property and proprietary rights and various governmental schemes.

### **Family Counseling Center:-**

As a part of social responsibility, college constituted the Family Counseling Centre. under the expert guidance of Mr. V. V. Shahapurkar, Rtd Principal Judge, Family Court, Pune which was inaugurated by Hon'ble Justice Anil Dave, Judge, Supreme Court of India on 10.08.2013. Within the span of these three years the family counseling centre has dealt with many cases and extended its helping hand to needy people for solving their family matters in peaceful and amicable way. This year for creating awareness among the people about various issues affecting the harmony of the family, centre published the magazine "Palavi" devoted to this subject. Poems and articles in this magazine are authored by eminent personalities like counselors from family court Pune, advocates, judges, social activist and students.

The college is having following Cells:-

- **The College Development Cell:-** This cell took the initiative in organizing various programs such as Personality Development Programs, Soft Skill Development,

Corporate Training Program etc. It invited various guest lecturers for delivering current knowledge to students.

- **Winter and Summer Internship Program:-**The Placement Cell provides internship to the students twice in the academic year i.e. summer internship and winter internship.
- **Guest Lectures :-** In meeting its objective of building functional knowledge and inculcating specific skills amongst students, the cell has also organized lecture series of eminent personalities.
- **Soft Skill Development Activities:-**For the personality development of students, cell organized lectures on soft development, communication skills etc.
- **Final Placement:-**The Cell endeavor to provide placement to the final year students in various law firms, corporate houses etc.
